Quarry Trail crosses private property via District easement. All users must stay on designated trail.

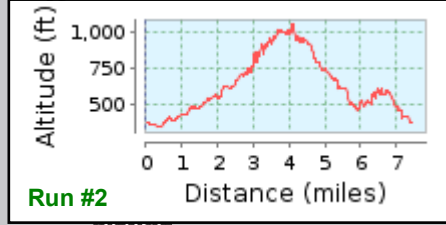
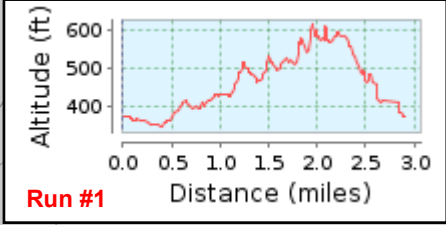
